

Requirements for the Geological Sciences Minor

The minor in geological sciences consists of 21 credit hours, of which at least 13 credit hours must be completed at the upper-division level. All courses must be completed with a grade of "C" (2.00 on a 4.00 scale) or better.

Prerequisite courses may be needed in order to complete the requirements of this minor.

GLG Upper Division Electives – 6 credit hours

Six credits of geological sciences electives (GLG prefix) at the 300-499 level. Courses in other related subjects may be approved by an academic advisor in the School of Earth and Space Exploration. Students should receive approval for substitutions prior to registration.

Advising Procedures: A student's major advisor can officially add the minor for the student using the code LAASTPHMIN. The DARS system will be used for tracking student progress and verifying completion of the minor.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Students cannot double count courses in their minor toward CORE classes in their major (related area courses are okay). Therefore, certain combinations of majors and minors are not permitted.

Incompatible Majors: BA in earth and environmental studies; BS in earth and space exploration (astrobiology and biogeosciences); BS in earth and space exploration (geological sciences)
